

CONCLUSIONS OF THE ATIBOX JUDGES' ROUND TABLE CONFERENCE in Hotel Park Plaza, Wroclaw, Poland, on May 28, 2010

During the ATIBOX judges round table conference 2010 a couple of emerging topics have been presented by Mrs. Dr. Iwona Magdziarska, Mr. Ralf Brinkman, and Mr. Danilo Giorgio, but major attention has been drawn to the upcomming topic – the white boxer.

Published articles by Mrs. Dr. Iwona Magdziarska, Mr. Ralf Brinkman and Mr. Peter Holzhausen were used as the starting point for the later vivid discussion by numerous audience from ATIBOX member countries, which finally resulted in two conclusions, unanimously accepted by the ATIBOX judges' round table conference:

- 1. A recommandation to divide the white boxer from coloured boxer in breeding; and
- 2. A recommandation to form the ATIBOX Breeding Committee who will work together with the Breeding Committee of German Boxer Club on all important issues regarding the future standard changes.
