



IMPORTANT NOTICE: Working Class Requirements for Atibox Show 2026

Dear Boxer friends and exhibitors,

As we prepare for the upcoming Atibox Show, we would like to issue a clear reminder regarding the entry requirements for the Working Class.

To preserve the highest standards of the Working Boxer, all dogs entered in the Working Class must hold a certificate of a complete and official FCI working trial.

This means the trial must evaluate all required disciplines (tracking, obedience, and protection), such as an official IGP (1, 2, or 3) or IGP-V. Other official international FCI disciplines, such as the FCI-IFH, are also fully accepted.

Exception for countries without protection work: We understand that in certain countries, protection work is forbidden by law. Dogs from these specific countries are exempt from the protection requirement, provided they submit official FCI certificates for the allowed disciplines.

Please note: Incomplete domestic or national tests that do not meet the full FCI international criteria will NOT be accepted for the Working Class at the Atibox World Championship, unless the legal exception mentioned above applies.

All Working Class entries will be carefully checked by our team upon submission. We kindly ask all exhibitors to verify their certificates before entering.

Thank you for your understanding and for helping us protect the standard of our beloved breed.
